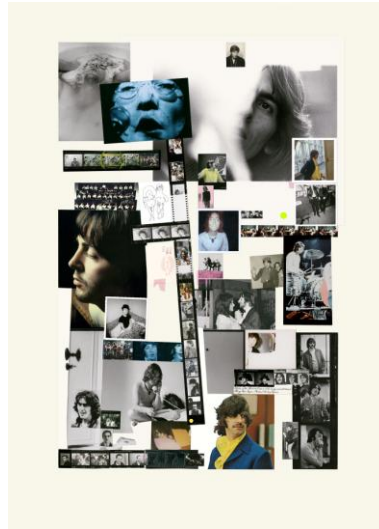

Previously a director of Waddington Galleries from 1974-94, Alan Cristea bought Waddington Graphics in 1995. Since then the gallery, from its base at 31 Cork Street, has grown into the largest dealer and publisher of 20<sup>th</sup>-Century and Contemporary prints in Europe. Over the years the gallery has expanded its remit and as well as publishing prints by the very best international artists, regularly exhibits paintings, works on paper, lightboxes and installations. The gallery has now taken over the corner gallery at 34 Cork Street and this exhibition will celebrate the re-opening of both newly refurbished spaces.

It will contain works by each of the 24 artists and estates represented by the gallery and celebrates the expansion and refurbishment of the new exhibition space encompassing 31 and 34 Cork Street.
