## Artist Biography

### Gordon Cheung

Gordon Cheung is of Hong Kong origin, born in London in 1975. Having grown up in both Hong Kong and England, he studied painting at Central Saint Martin's College of Art and the Royal College of Art, graduating in 2001. He is best known for his epic, hallucinogenic landscapes constructed using an array of media including stock page listings, spray paint, acrylic, and most recently inkjet and woodblock printing. He won the Jerwood Contemporary Painters Prize in 2008, and was awarded the Arts Council of England Individual Arts Award in 2005. In 2014 Cheung took part in the Royal Academy of Arts Summer Exhibition and in 2015 he exhibited work inspired by the Dutch Golden Age at the Alan Cristea Gallery. Cheung currently lives and works in London.
