## Artist Biography

### Julian Opie (b. 1958)

Julian Opie studied at Goldsmiths College from 1979 until 1982, and has since become one of the UK's best known contemporary artists, exhibiting widely both nationally and internationally. He works in a variety of media; inspired by aspects of visual culture such as manga comic books, classical portraiture and billboard signs. His works have been realised in silkscreen, vinyl, LCD, LED, lenticular and flocking, and he continues to push the boundaries of 'traditional' artistic practice.

Julian Opie presented new recent works in a major exhibition at the Alan Cristea Gallery in 2018. He lives and works in London.
