## Artist Biography

### Ben Johnson (b. 1946)

Ben Johnson was born in Llandudno, Wales. He did his MA at the Royal College of Art, London, and held first solo exhibition in New York in 1969. Johnson's works are mainly large and highly detailed machine made pictures of architecture, buildings and cityscapes, which has led to him being the first painter to be made an honorary Fellow of the Royal Institute of British Architects in 1990. His cityscapes so far have included Hong Kong, Jerusalem, Zurich and Liverpool. Johnson had his first solo exhibition of paintings at the Alan Cristea Gallery in 2010. He lives and works in London. In 2014 Johnson won the 'Threadneedle Visitors Choice Award' for his painting Room of the Revolutionary.
